SELECTION CRITERIA NT MASTERS SPORTSPERSON OF THE YEAR

Awarded to a master's athlete who has achieved outstanding results in respect to their performance in recognised national or international competitions.

Eligibility:

- Nominees must be considered of a masters age by their National Sporting Organisation.
- Achievements must be made at a national or international level.
- Performances and achievements must have occurred between 1 January 2026 and 31 December 2026.
- Nominees primary place of residence must be within the Northern Territory between 1 January 2026 and 31 December 2026.

Evidence of and information about the following should be provided:

- Overview of the nominee's experience, and background to support the nomination
- Competition details Inclusive of level, results, and significance
- Supporting Information - Summarise the pathway to qualify for the competition, the quality, and depth
- Significance of the achievement in terms of Territory sport – For example: Breaking or setting records, raising recognition for the Territory, being selected to represent the territory, positively impacting the Territory

Attachments:

Various attachments will be requested to support the nomination, comprising of:

- Minimum of 2 high quality photographs of the nominee
- Supporting documentation, including official results, news articles, social media posts, testimonials, or other supporting evidence
