SELECTION CRITERIA

ERIC JOHNSTON COACH OF THE YEAR

Awarded to an individual who has done all of the following:

- displayed strength of character in the role of coaching
- contributed to the development of the sport
- demonstrated personal development and achievement as a coach and achieved outstanding athlete performances in national or international competitions

Nominations are open to all paid or unpaid coaches with respective National Sporting Organisation coaching accreditation.

Evidence of and information about the following should be provided:

- Coaching achievements within the eligibility period
- Competition level and standard coached (i.e., regional, territory, national or international)
- Results, i.e. final placing/position, achievements, records achieved and set of participants/team coached
 - Copy of official results from the relevant competition/event to be attached.
- Quality and depth of competition
- Significance of the achievement in terms of Territory sport
 - Adopts a person-centred approach to coaching by helping participants to develop their skills, confidence, resilience and develops a positive attitude toward sport and active recreation.
 - Promotes inclusion
- Invests in their development of self and holds appropriate sport specific accreditation

Eligibility period

To be eligible for nomination, the performances and achievements attained must have occurred between 1 January 2024 and 31 December 2024.

Status as a Territorian:

Nominees not resident in the NT between 1 January 2024 and 31 December 2024 may be considered for this award if they have current or previous strong links to the Territory and Territory Sport.
