

NT SPORTS AWARDS

SELECTION CRITERIA NT VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR

Awarded to an individual who has displayed outstanding conduct as a volunteer in the support, administration, promotion and/or delivery of services.

Important: Nominees must contribute to sport in an unpaid capacity. While unpaid coaches and volunteers are not excluded from this award, the nomination will not be assessed on these roles and must focus on their contributions beyond coaching and officiating.

Eligibility:

- Achievements must contribute to Northern Territory-based sport.
- Nominees must provide support to sport, in a non-paid role, outside of the scope of coach and official roles.
- Performances and achievements must have occurred between 1 January 2026 and 31 December 2026.
- Nominees primary place of residence must be within the Northern Territory between 1 January 2026 and 31 December 2026.

Evidence of and information about the following should be provided:

- Overview of the nominee's experience, and background to support the nomination
- Key achievements – For example: Led fundraising efforts to secure funds in support of the NT Team travelling interstate for competitions
- Supporting Information – Further evidence to support the nomination
- Significance of the achievement in terms of Territory sport – For example: Dedicated substantial time to volunteer in sport, promoting inclusive opportunities and reducing inequalities, contribution to financial stability of club and/or sport, enhancing community engagement, Increasing participation.

Attachments:

Various attachments will be requested to support the nomination, comprising of:

- Minimum of 2 high quality photographs of the nominee
- Supporting documentation, including official results, news articles, social media posts, testimonials, or other supporting evidence
