2014 Project Round 2 – Assessment Report

The 2014 Arts Grants Project Round 2 offered up to \$15 000 per grant to support activities in all regions of the Northern Territory for research, development, promotion and presentation. A separate category prioritises emerging artists and offered up to \$10 000 in funding for projects to support opportunities for early career artists.

\$135 000 in grants awarded

The 2014 Project Round 2 closed on 20 October 2014. Arts NT received 41 eligible applications across four categories - Arts Development, Presentation and Promotion, Skills Development, and Emerging Artists.

\$135 000 in funding was offered to 12 successful applications following the decisions made by a peer assessment panel.

Assessment Panel

The Project Round 2 assessment meeting was held on 26 November 2014 and included Ms Gillian Banks (Chair), Ms Marie Munkara, Mr Phillip Eaton, Mr Leon Tripp and Mr Tim Newth. The 2014 Project Round assessment panel provides a spread of expertise across regions, artform or discipline, arts management, regions, gender and cultural backgrounds.

The panel felt this application round was highly competitive with a number of strong applications demonstrating and articulating the value of the project to the benefitting communities.

General feedback from the panel and for future applications included:

- the overall high standard of grant applications in a competitive round of funding;
- the importance of reading the Arts Grants Guidelines; and
- the benefit of speaking to a Regional Arts Broker to ensure application is eligible and complete.

Art Forms and Regions

The panel considered the merit of all applications against the project category objectives and assessment criteria. The panel also considered track record of support, art form and regional spread, diversity of applicants and participants including new applicants, Indigenous, youth, disability and cultural diversity.

Statistics

- 12 funded applications: 29% success rate
- 5 group applications: 46% of total funding
- 7 individual applicants: 54% of total funding
- 6 Indigenous projects: 47% of total funding.




Figure 1 Artform




Figure 2 Region of Applicant




Figure 3 Project Reach
