
Title: AVIATION - GOVERNMENT/AIRLINE AGREEMENTS

Cabinet approved the execution of the proposed Memorandum of Understanding between the Territory Government, Northern Airlines and East-West Airlines subject to the deletion of the word "suitable" from recital A(b) of the Memorandum of Understanding and the insertion of the words -

"a level of service which is satisfactory and not less than that which exists at the date of the signing of the Memorandum of Understanding".

Cabinet agreed that recital A(b) would then read -

"would ensure that a level of service which is satisfactory and not less than that which exists at the date of the signing of the Memorandum of Understanding is provided without subsidy by the Territory to the small communities previously serviced by Operations and between communities now served by Ansett and TAA and that the level of service required would not in itself result in an increase in fares".
