The Office of Disability in the Northern Territory Government wrote this book.



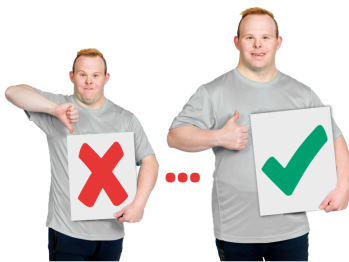
When you see the word **we** it means the Northern Territory Government.

How to nominate

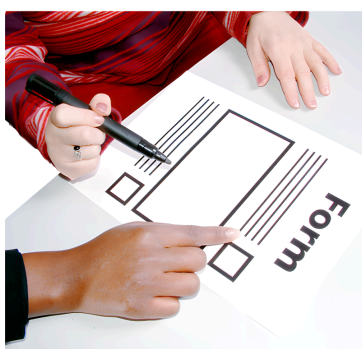


Use your computer to print or fill in the nomination form.

What are the different Awards?

1



Excellence in Rights Promotion and Empowerment Award



This award is for people who help you to:

- understand your rights



- have more choice and control in your life
- be more independent.

Excellence in Innovation Award



This award is for:

- people with excellent ideas to make your life easier.

Inclusive Communities Award



This award is for:

- people who make you feel welcome in the community
- businesses that make it easier for you to access services

Excellence in Service Provision Award

This award is for:

- service providers that you think are excellent.

Excellence in Support Award

This award is for a person who:

- supports you
- makes a big difference in your life.

Excellence in Education and Employment Award



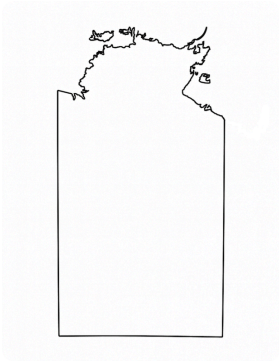
This award is for:
