

NT SPORTS AWARDS

SELECTION CRITERIA NT OFFICIAL OF THE YEAR

Awarded to an individual who has achieved outstanding results in officiating national or international competitions.

Eligibility:

- Nominees must be an accredited official.
- Achievements must be made at a national or international level.
- Performances and achievements must have occurred between 1 January 2026 and 31 December 2026.
- Nominees primary place of residence must be within the Northern Territory between 1 January 2026 and 31 December 2026.

Evidence of and information about the following should be provided:

- Overview of the nominee's experience, and background to support the nomination
- Competition Details inclusive of name, level, and standard of officiating
- Significance of the achievement in terms of Territory sport – For example: Depth and significance of competition, breaking or setting records, raising recognition for the Territory, being selected to represent the territory, positively impacting the Territory
- Contribution to the broader officiating community – For example: Providing leadership and support to other officials, investing in self-development

Attachments:

Various attachments will be requested to support the nomination, comprising of:

- Minimum of 2 high quality photographs of the nominee
- Supporting documentation, including official results, news articles, social media posts, testimonials, or other supporting evidence
- Copy of Current sport specific official accreditation
- Reference from a qualified Peak Sporting Body or National Sporting Organisation representative that oversees Officials for their sport.
